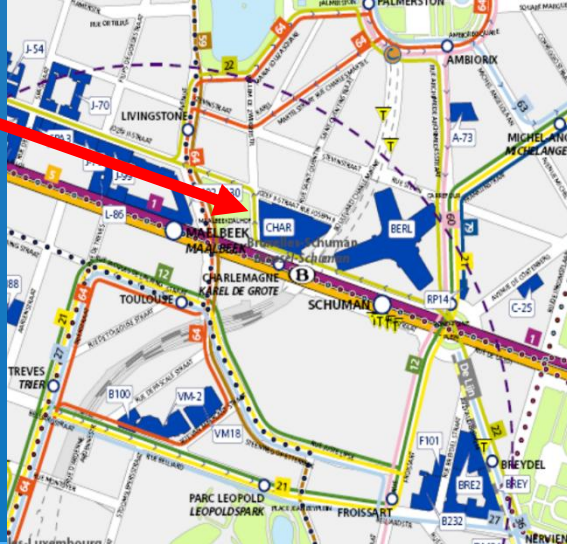

Session principles ^[1/2]

- focus on the emerging issues on the European agenda
- avoid duplication or “just more of the same”
(Check the wiki archive for previous years!)
- avoid seminar style (not a series of presentations)
- time distribution: 50/50 – speakers / audience
- each speaker - 3 min “punchy” statements (timer)

Session principles ^[2/2]

- not more than 4 speakers in Workshops
